## What's Happening?

If you elect medical coverage during this year's annual enrollment, you will receive prescription drug coverage through Capital Rx for the new plan year.

## When is this Effective?

Coverage through Capital Rx begins July 1, 2023.

## What Does this Mean for Me?

There are four key changes to know:



**1. New ID Cards:** Capital Rx will provide you with a new member ID card. Beginning July 1, 2023, please use your new Capital Rx ID card and dispose of your old prescription drug carrier's ID card.

**2. Formulary:** The formulary is how your prescription drug carrier classifies the drugs it covers. While Capital Rx has a formulary that is a very close match to your current carrier, there are minor differences. We will provide you with detailed instructions for how to check your current prescriptions against the new formulary.



**3. Mail order through Walmart Pharmacy:** Mail order prescriptions with Capital Rx will be filled through Walmart Mail Order Pharmacy. If you currently have a mail order prescription, Capital Rx will work directly with your current mail order pharmacy to transfer your prescription. *Please note: only valid prescriptions with refills will be transferred.* Look for more information coming soon on the specific steps to take.



**4. Convenient ways to connect:** Capital Rx offers easy access to your benefits through a mobile app and online member portal. Go to one place to:

- Search for the lowest cost drug at nearby pharmacies
- Find the closest pharmacy
- View your claims
- Download your digital Capital Rx ID card
- View which drugs are covered under your plan
